Introduction

Ajara is a one of the gorgeous parts of Georgia, with the subtropical climate, surrounded on one side by mountain range and the Black Sea, on another.

The most popular wine tour in Ajara region is associated with "Ajarian Wine House" (AWH, Shateau type), which was established in 2010 at the entrance of Keda district. It is a small winery with at a beautiful location 15 minute-drive from the capital of Ajara, Batumi. It was built on the ruins of an 18th century historical winery in Ajara.

The overall mission of AWH is to restore the historical winemaking traditions of Ajara and re-introduce some old, unique wines such as "Chkhaveri", that are characteristic to this region.

New vine species and collection wines are also produced. Guests have the chance to taste wines produced from unique vine species, get acquainted with Ajarian cuisine

and folklore, to have a walk around "Chkhaveri" vineyards, and to purchase some local folk souvenirs as well as participate in wine making. Ajara Wine House offer an unforgettable experience to the wine appreciators, an exquisite service and the warm welcome to Ajara, that will stay in your hearts for a long time

Batumi – Keda district villages

All the tourist routes of mountaineous Ajara pass through the Keda district villages. The wine tour in Keda gives you the opportunity to visit the “Ajarian Wine House” as well as family wine sellars, to taste the offered wine, to learn about the life of the locals, their cuisine and folklore; to browse vineyards and participate in the harvest, and of course to enjoy the delicious wine and hospitality of the local residents. You can also visit the Acharistskali Gorge; the church of the Virgin Mary; the Makhuntseti waterfall, the arced bridges of Queen Tamar, St. George's Church, St. Nicholas's Church and the Keda Ethnographic Museum.




